### **We Assist with the Following Services on a Walk-in Basis**

- State I.D. & Birth Certificates (for clients born in Ohio; limited to the first 100 people only)
  - Walk-ins every Monday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
- Clothing & Household Items
  - Wal-ins every Monday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
- Bus Tokens (employment and medically related purposes only)
  - Walk-ins every Monday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
  - \* Due to limited supplies, tokens often available only during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of the month*
- Food Pantry (serving clients in zip codes ending in 02, 03, 13, 19, 25, 29, and 32 only)
  - Every Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- Pharmacy
  - New & recertifying clients every Monday, Wednesday, & Thursday morning; first 10 clients only
  - Re-fills every Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
  - Re-fills every Saturday from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- UC Comprehensive Center
  - Free blood pressure checks, nutrition counseling, and other health screenings are available every Saturday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Services are provided by faculty and students of the University of Cincinnati.

### **The Following Documentation is Required for Assistance:**

1. Picture I.D., Social Security Cards, or a Printout for the entire household.
2. Verification of income of entire household.
  - \* Please note: income verification is not necessary for assistance from the food pantry*
3. Current proof of address (e.g., utility bill, lease, or a piece of dated mail)
4. For bus tokens, proof of employment or documentation of medical appointments
5. For pharmacy, prescription and proof of all income and expenses (lease, utility bills, phone bill, medical bills, etc.) are required.

### **Rent, Utilities, and Furniture**

- We take only the first 30 applications for furniture on the first Wednesday of each month.
- By appointment only. Those seeking help must fill out a Request Form for assistance. The form can be filled out in person (M-F, 8:00-4:30), by phone (421-0602), or at [www.svdpcincinnati.org](http://www.svdpcincinnati.org)
